High-end intralogistics: SCIO subsidiaries 4am Robotics and 4logix Intralogistics showcase the future of automation at LogiMAT 2024

Leinfelden-Echterdingen, January 2024. Automated intralogistics processes from A-Z: 4am Robotics and 4logix Intralogistics - both corporate brands of the SCIO Automation Group - will be showcasing their customer-specific Autonomous Mobile Robot innovations and Warehouse & Logistics solutions at LogiMAT 2024 at their joint stand (East Entrance, Stand ES43). An Autonomous Mobile Cobot development will make its debut and be unveiled to trade visitors on the first day of the trade fair.

From customized and modern conveyor and system technology, autonomous tugger trains and forklifts to mobile cobots - when combined, the solutions offered by 4am and 4logix provide a seamless, automated material flow for production. At LogiMAT, 4am will primarily be presenting their autonomous forklift (AFi-H) developed in 2023, autonomous mobile cobot (AMC-L) and autonomous mobile cobot roller conveyor (AMC-RC) in productive use.

In addition to these products, 4am will be exclusively showing off the big brother of the AMC-L, which won the VDI Logistics Innovation Award 2023, at LogiMAT: the AMC-H combines all the benefits of the AMC-L, such as its modular design and minimal footprint with a higher payload and reach. At the same time, its state-of-the-art product innovation has the ergonomic abilities of a human employee, whilst being able to map many more applications as a result of its wide variety of expansion options. The AMC-H will take the floor on the morning of the first day of the trade fair.

4logix Intralogistics specializes in warehouse technology and intralogistics and focuses on warehouse automation as an integral part of the smart factory. Trade visitors will be able to see 4logix's integration expertise for themselves every day of the trade fair.
